A Master's Degree for Master Teachers M.Ed. in Curriculum & Instruction with a minor in Reading or Teacher Leadership

This accelerated program is intended for elite scholars who appreciate the value of studying on campus with other serious scholars while enjoying the benefit of completing their degree without taking too much time from their teaching during the regular school year. The degree plan is the same as found in the catalog. To make this happen, we are making more courses available in the summer.

Reading Minor

This degree is designed to support the needs of practicing teachers who want to reestablish themselves as scholars and provide instructional and curricular leadership from within. Students will enroll in 15 hours this summer, 15 hours next summer, and 3 hours each regular semester during the coming school year. Both of the regular semester classes will be online. Students who begin this summer can complete their degrees next summer in August if they enroll in all courses as they are offered.

Teacher Leadership

This degree is designed to support the needs of practicing teachers who want to reestablish themselves as scholars and provide instructional and curricular leadership from within. Students will enroll in 15 hours this summer, 15 hours next summer, and 3 hours each regular semester during the coming school year. One of the summer classes will be online and both of the regular semester classes will be online. Students who begin this summer can complete their degrees next summer in August if they enroll in all courses as they are offered.
